## LEAGUE RULES

### 1. Participation

Any club affiliated to Worcester Badminton Association shall be eligible.

### 2. League Organisation

(a) The league shall consist of Four Divisional Groups – Mens, Ladies, Mixed Doubles and Veterans

(b) There shall be a maximum of eight teams per division.

(c) The Mens, Ladies and Mixed parts shall consist of one Premier division and then Divisions 1,2,3 etc . The Veterans part shall consist of Divisions 1, 2, 3 etc. The number of divisions being governed by the number of teams entering the League

(d) Venues for matches shall be as directed by the League Committee. Any club changing venue for matches should first obtain approval from the League Committee.

(e) Clubs wishing to enter a team must comply with Rule 9 of the Worcestershire Badminton Association. In the event of a club being found to have fielded any player before the affiliation fees have been paid, the games played by the player(s) concerned shall, retrospectively, be awarded to the other team. A non returnable entrance fee of £5.00 per team shall be paid to the League Secretary with the League Entry form.

(f) Any club not attending the fixture meeting will not be eligible to play in the league for that season. Re-entry into the League the following season will be one division lower.

(g) All matches arranged at the Fixtures meeting should be for dates before the 7th April.

(h) In the Veterans league, players will be eligible to play from the date they become 40 years of age.

(i) Clubs shall be allowed a maximum of two teams in any one division.

### 3. League Teams

(a) Mens teams shall consist of three pairs of men. Mixed teams shall consist of 3 Ladies and 3 Men. Ladies teams shall consist of four ladies. The Ladies should play in order of ability. Veterans teams shall consist of 4 players and is open to men and ladies, and teams can consist of any combination of any combination.

(b) All team members must be bona fide club members for which an affiliation fee has been paid to the Association, otherwise games played may be null and void. In the case of being a member of two clubs, only one affiliation fee is payable. All players must be registered with the BE for all the clubs they play for.

(c) No player shall represent more than one club in the same divisional group (i.e. Mens, Ladies, Mixed or Veterans) of the League otherwise the games played for the second club shall be null and void.

(d) Clubs entering more than one team in the same part of the League (Mens, Ladies , Mixed and Veterans) must nominate as follows:-

Mens and Mixed – if two teams – four first team players

– if three teams – four first and four second team players

Ladies and Veterans – if two teams – three first team players

– if three teams – three first and three second team players.

(e) Nominated players for ALL teams in each part of the League shall be sent to the League secretary BEFORE the clubs' first match in that part of the League. Failing this the League Committee will determine the nominations based on the score card submitted.

(f) Any player so nominated shall be eligible to play for a team in a higher division but shall not be eligible to play for a team in a lower division. If a player so nominated subsequently plays for a team in a lower division, his/her scores for that team shall be null and void. From this point onwards, all aces scored by this player for any team in a lower division shall be null and void.

(g) Any player who plays three matches in total for teams in higher divisions shall become a nominated player at that level and shall be covered by the same restrictions as a nominated player.

(h) Where a club has two teams playing in the same division, they shall nominate all players in their higher teams. Players from the lower team would only be able to play once for the higher team. If a player then plays for the higher team on a second occasion, those games shall become null and void. The nomination system shall still apply to a team that a club has in a higher division (League Rule 4n should also be noted at this point).

(i) All nominated players must play at least 3 matches for the nominated or higher team.

(j) When a player has played no more than twice for a team for which he/she has been nominated, a club may apply in writing to the League Secretary, stating the reason for denomination. Should such a denomination be granted then the player may not be played in a higher team during the rest of the season.

#### 4. League Matches

(a) Mens and Mixed matches to consist of nine rubbers each of two games – 21 aces per game (setting permitted) with each pair playing the opposing pairs. The order shall be 1v1, 2v2, 3v3, 2v1, 3v2, 1v3, 3v1, 1v2, 2v3. In the event of the 2 games being shared, a third game shall be played to 11 points, with the winner of the 2nd game the first server. Change ends at 6 points. At 10 points all, there will be setting up to 15 points—the winners will be the team being 2 points ahead. At 14 all the winners will be the winner of the next point.

(b) Ladies and Veterans matches to consist of six rubbers each, best of three games – 21 aces per game (setting permitted) with pairings as follows:-

1 + 2 : 3 + 4 : 1 + 3 : 2 + 4 : 1 + 4 : 2 + 3 playing the identical opposing pairings.

(c) All match results are decided by the number of rubbers won. In the event of these being equal the match is drawn.

(d) In the event of a club being unable to field a complete team, the team will forfeit the games un-played. In the event of a club being unable to field sufficient eligible players to gain a result, the match may be claimed by the opposing team as a conceded match (a walkover). The team claiming the match will be deemed to have played this match and will be awarded the full number of games and aces available in this match, and the team conceding this match will be deemed not to have played this match (note rule 4m).

(e) All unfinished rubbers shall be replayed from the start.

(f) Club secretaries must inform the League Secretary of match dates.

(g) Matches once arranged may only be postponed due to non-availability of hall, extreme weather or other conditions to be agreed by the league committee. In the event of postponement **both clubs** must inform the divisional league secretary in writing within 24 hours of the original fixture date giving reasons for the postponement. If no such communication is received the club(s) shall be deemed to have conceded this match (Note rule 4m). Any rearranged matches must be played by the end of April and the League Secretary and Divisional League Secretaries must be informed in writing by the home team, and confirmed by the away team, within 4 weeks of the original arranged date.

(h) Any club postponing matches except as above, may have the match awarded to their opponents. Agreement between clubs to waive the above rule may result in the match being declared null and void, but the league committee reserve the right to direct that any postponed match be re-arranged or take any other action as it sees fit when the result detrimentally affect a 3rd team.

(i) The official score card will be provided by the home team.

(j) The result of the match must be entered onto the FixturesLive web site within 24 hours of the match finishing, by the home captain – as recorded on FixturesLive. If the result has not been entered onto FixturesLive within 24 hours of the match finishing, then the Divisional League secretary must be notified and a copy of the scorecard supplied within 48 hours. The home team also must supply the divisional league secretary with a copy of the official scorecard within 7 days of the match result otherwise 2 points will be deducted.

(k) For all matches played after 7th April, the score card must be scanned and emailed to the relevant Divisional League Secretary contact for the league within 24 hours otherwise 2 points will be deducted.

(l) The cost of the league matches will be borne by the home team.

(m) A team must play all but one of its fixtures otherwise all matches will be null and void, and the team placed at the bottom of

the division to be relegated to a lower division the following season. A team failing to complete any of its matches will be deemed to have withdrawn from the League.

(n) Any club with two teams in the same division must play those matches first otherwise the team may lose the results of matches played before these are completed. The ranking of the two teams would be decided from those results.

(o) Where a no scorecard is received, the away team may be allowed to claim any points, rubbers, games and aces won in this match but will not be able to claim a walkover, unless they were given a walkover.

(p) A team not having a playing pair per available court ready to play within 15 minutes of the starting time of a match, including knocking up, shall forfeit the first rubber, unless that rubber can be played within the time allowed for the whole match. Order of play shall be as outlined on the scorecard, see rules 4(a) and 4(b).

(q) If a club is obliged to vacate its premises before a match has been completed, the home club shall forfeit all outstanding games, unless the away team has contravened rule 4(p).

(r) In the event of a match being conceded, both teams must notify the divisional league secretary stating the reason for the match being conceded.

(s) In the event of an injury to a player during the course of a match, no substitutions will be allowed that affect the final score. However, at the discretion of both teams a substitute player can play but their scores will not count.

(t) In accordance with League Rule 4d, a team shall forfeit the result of any game where the full name of the player (as registered with BE) is omitted from the score sheet or is illegible. In the event of 2 players in a club having the same name, it should be clear on the scorecard which player is which.

(u) Should any conceded match detrimentally affect the promotion / relegation prospect of a 3rd party team, the League Committee reserve the right to take any steps to remedy the situation.

#### **5. Divisional Placings**

(a) Two points will be awarded for a win and one for a tie.

(b) In the event of a match being conceded, two points will be awarded for the win and two points will be deducted from the team who conceded the match.

(c) The final placing of a club in its divisional group shall be determined by the number of points gained. In the event of points being equal the Club with the higher rubber difference between won and lost shall be placed higher in the division. In the event of the rubber difference also being equal, the Club with the higher games difference between the won and lost shall be placed higher in the division. In the event of games difference being equal then aces won divided by aces lost shall be worked out and the higher result shall determine final league places.

#### **6. Promotion and Relegation**

At the discretion of the League Committee the League Committee will state whether play-offs take place and if they are to be arranged the date will be published at the beginning of the season.

(a) All divisions—one up and one down.

(b) All divisions—second from bottom team in a division shall play the team finishing second from top in the lower division in a play-off match (see 7).

(c) In the event that no play-offs take place, promotion and relegation will be one up and one down, apart from the bottom division, which will be 2 up, and the next to bottom division will be one up and 2 down.

(d) If a team opts not to take promotion, it shall be demoted to the bottom division.

#### **7. Play-off Matches**

(a) Play-off matches will all take place at a neutral venue at the end of April. The cost will be £10 per team, payable on the day. The team from the higher division will provide the shuttles for their match, with costs shared by their opponents. Any team failing to turn up for the match will automatically forfeit the match and will play in the lower division the following season.

(b) To be eligible to play in a Play-off match, players should have played at least 50% of the matches for the team. Players who subsequently become nominated for a higher team would no longer be eligible (see rule 3g). In the event of an ineligible player taking part in the match, all their games will be awarded to the opposition. If a club is unable to field a complete team of eligible players the League will consider granting special dispensation to any player who has not quite fulfilled the necessary 50% appearances.

(c) In the event that two teams from the same club would be involved in a match, no match will take place and the teams will remain in the same divisions the following season.

(d) The League committee may decide not to hold play-offs in any given year, if circumstances deem it appropriate.

### **8. Shuttles**

(a) All shuttles must be cork based and conform the Law 4 of the Laws of Badminton. In addition to this the skirt of all shuttlecocks used in the three Premier Divisions and four First Divisions of the league and in Veterans Division 2 must be made of natural goose feathers.

(b) The home team must ensure an adequate supply of such shuttlecocks.

(c) Shuttlecocks of the same make, type, and speed must be used throughout the match.

### **9. Trophies**

See Association Rule 10.

(a) A £50 fine will be levied if the trophies are not returned prior to one month before the presentation.

(b) Trophies not collected at the presentation will be retained by WBA.

(c) It is the responsibility of the winner of the trophy to have the trophy engraved otherwise a fine of £10 will be levied.

### **10. General**

The committee reserves the right to take action against any club or player who is found not to be acting in the spirit of the game.

#### **Recommendation:**

(a) It is recommended that teams should make contact the week before a match to confirm the details for the match.

(b) Clubs sharing the same facilities:-

Where one or more clubs use the same facilities, a sub committee should be formed comprising of two members from each club.

The duties of this sub committee are:-

– To confirm the established use of all clubs concerned of the facility.

– To deal with any conflicts arising as a result of the use of the facility

– To judge on any members conflict of interests reference the clubs concerned

Should any matter arise which cannot be satisfactorily resolved, then it should be passed on to the league committee for advice.

(c) Teams shall be written onto the scorecard before the start of the match. Each team shall write their own players in block letters.

(d) Clubs should play the majority of higher team matches before all lower team matches have been completed.
